IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. Relocation of the Confederate Monument as identified in the Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement for the reason and to the location specified in the Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement be and is hereby approved and deemed compliant with N.C. Gen. Stat. §100-2.1.

2. The Court further finds that the parties have standing and that any of the parties to this cause may seek to enforce compliance with the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement.

3. As a result of the findings herein, and upon agreement of the parties, the Complaint filed by Plaintiffs on December 2, 2022 in this action is hereby dismissed.

4. The Restraining Order entered by the undersigned on March 30, 2023, be and same is hereby dissolved in order for Defendant and the County of Chowan to comply with the Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement heretofore filed in this action.

5. Each party shall bear their own costs, including but not limited to attorney's fees.
